ADDITIONAL RULES & GUIDELINES:

Competition will be run according to the Rules & Regulations of the S.O.B.H.D. and ScotDance Canada.

No refunds will be given.

Age categories will be established based on entries received. Age is taken as of day of competition.

Competitors must report to the marshalling area when called or risk disqualification.

All dancers must be in full dress to receive awards.

Medals will be presented in each age category. Keeper awards will be presented for the High Aggregate winner in each age group, except Primary, based on all dances.

Judge's decision is final. There will be no access to the judge's sheets, nor any communication with the judge.

Any protest must be lodged, in writing, within 48 hours of the event accompanied by a \$30.00 fee. Fee will be refunded if protest is upheld.

SDPEI Fee is allocated to funding for provincial selection competition.
