AWARDS AND COMPETITION RULES

The Hugh J MacDonald Memorial Award will be presented to the top Pre-Premier Dancer of the Day (excluding Primary) and the top Premier Dancer of the Day at the completion of the awards ceremony. At least six dancers must compete in a group to be eligible.

The Hector Festival Trophy is awarded to the Premier dancer who resides in Pictou County and accumulates the most points overall during the Hector Festival.

The SOBHD rules govern this competition. Scrutineering shall be conducted as recommended by SOBHD. Judges decisions are final. Competitors *must* show a current SOBHD registration card or awards earned will be withheld. Classes will be divided after closing date for entries at the discretion of the competition chairperson. First to enter, last to dance. Competitors must report promptly to dance area when called or risk disqualification. Dancers must be in full dress, including slippers, to receive awards. Protests may be lodged in writing according to SOBHD rules. The deCoste Centre will not be responsible or liable for lost articles, accidents, injuries, or illness to the competitors or spectators. High aggregate trophies will be awarded to dancers with highest dance points based on medals awarded. Trophies will be awarded in all categories except Primary and oldest Premier category. Cash awards will be given in oldest Premier category.
